



Call for Instructors

American Language and Culture Program

Summer 2019

The Global Studies in the Arts and Humanities (GSAH) is recruiting graduate student instructors for its summer reverse study-abroad program, the American Language and Culture program. Instructors will be responsible for delivering the American culture content sections. American culture content sections will explore American identity by looking at different ways Americans define themselves in local (Michigan/Midwest), national, global contexts. The program also offers students a variety of excursions locally and to Detroit, and the East Coast (instructor participation is not expected). The instructors will also coordinate their curriculum with English Language Center instructors who will be delivering English Language sections.

- Program Dates on East Lansing Campus: July 15 – August 2
- 1 ¼ hours per day – 12 to 13 class sessions – classes should end by 1 pm at the latest
- Class size: approximately 20 students per section
- Payment will be \$2500 per section

Applications should include

- CV
- Course module for 1 or 2 class meetings: include a description (less than 300 words) explaining what aspect of American culture in its local, national, and global contexts the module would emphasize
- Short list of potential readings appropriate for non-native English speaking undergraduates
- Schedule of availability during the summer before the program begins for curriculum development
